- 3. An income statement or profit/loss statement for the periods of January 1, 2019 through June 30, 2019, and January 1, 2020 through June 30, 2020 (must be shown as separate periods for comparison purposes).
- 4. A completed and signed W-9 form.



5. Evidence to support eligible expenses. This may include utility statements, mortgage or lease schedules, payroll reports, accounts payable records and other accounting records to validate your business expenses.

Section 7 – Acknowledgments and Signature

By signing this application, the applicant acknowledges the following:

- 1. Grant funds will be used to cover extraordinary business expenses or business income losses directly related to the COVID-19 public health emergency and related State of Minnesota Executive Orders.
- 2. Grant funds will not be used to pay rent, mortgages, payroll costs or other cost when such costs were reimbursed by federal Paycheck Protection Program loan funds.
- 3. Grant funds will not duplicate funding received from a City or Township.
- 4. Benton County retains final and sole authority to approve or deny applications for grant funds, based on the recommendation of the Benton Economic Partnership.
- 5. Grant recipient will allow an inspection and copying of business records reasonably required by the Benton Economic Partnership and Benton County to satisfy any subrecipient monitoring requirements.
- 6. <u>Data Privacy Notice</u> Benton County is subject to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 13, commonly known as the Data Practices Act. When businesses apply for a grant from the County, financial information about the business, including credit reports, financial statements, net worth calculations, business plans, income and expense projections, balance sheets, customer lists, income tax returns and design, market, and feasibility studies not paid for with public funds are all private data. However, once the business receives a grant from the County, certain information provided by the applicant will be public data, <u>except the following data will remain private</u>: business plans, income and expense projections not related to the financial assistance provided, customer lists, income tax returns, and design, market, and feasibility studies not paid for with public funds.
